## Ouellette Congratulates General Motors for Buick Regal

**(Queen's Park)** –Today in the Ontario Legislature, Jerry J. Ouellette, MPP Oshawa called on Dalton McGuinty's Health Minister to agree to a public inquiry to resolve the many unanswered questions that remain about the serious, and potentially criminal, abuses of the taxpayer money that occurred with the McGuinty Liberal e-Health Scandal.

Ouellette questioned the Minister on the suspicious timing of the McGuinty Liberals shutting down public accounts committee hearings into the eHealth scandal, just as the CEO of e-Health, Rita Burak, said she saw enough evidence of criminal activity to get a legal opinion.

“It is only fair to demand the full and complete truth as to why so much money could disappear, while so many Liberal friends and insiders get rich on untendered contracts,” stated Ouellette.

A public inquiry will be able to use independent investigative tools to provide insight as to why this happened, who benefited and what role Dalton McGuinty played throughout. This investigation is necessary to get to the bottom of this scandal.

“There are a number of troubling, unanswered questions from the Auditor General's Report that Ontario families deserve answers to.” added Ouellette, “That is why a full public inquiry is necessary.”
