OUELLETTE CONTINUES TO PRESSURE MCGUINTY OVER AUTO SECTOR JOBS

MPP disappointed Liberal government has failed to offer constructive proposals to assist domestic automotive industry

(Queen's Park) – Oshawa MPP Jerry Ouellette stepped up his attacks on the McGuinty government over the recent announcement by General Motors that the Oshawa Truck Assembly Plant will shut down for an indefinite period.

Mr. Ouellette pointed out to the legislature that the Oshawa truck plant has been recognized numerous times for efficiency and the quality of vehicles produced by the dedicated, hard working employees. In fact, J.D. Power and Associates just today awarded the Oshawa truck plant with another initial quality award for the Chevrolet Silverado. He also expressed his frustration over the McGuinty government's lack of vision and cooperation when it comes to our local automotive industry.

"I cannot understand why I stand in this House time after time and express my concern over the changes coming in the auto sector and the Cabinet doesn't see the light", Ouellette stated to the legislative assembly.

The Oshawa MPP said the government's job is to create an environment where business can flourish and Ontarians can live, work, and raise a family.

"The plan, quite frankly, isn't working", Mr. Ouellette reiterated to the Premier.
