## **e-Health Scandal – What is McGuinty trying to hide now?**

*Ouellette disappointed that McGuinty Liberals vote down motion to question former e-Health CEO and Chair of the Board of Directors*

**(Queen's Park)** – During hearings today of the Public Accounts committee, a motion was put forth to bring Sarah Kramer, former CEO and President of eHealth Ontario and Dr. Alan Hudson, Chair of the Board of Directors for eHealth Ontario before the committee to answer the committee's questions. The five Liberal MPPs present for this committee vote, voted down the motion, Jerry Ouellette MPP, Oshawa reported.

Just what is Premier McGuinty trying to hide now?

Over the past two weeks, Oshawa MPP, Jerry Ouellette, who is currently a member of the Public Accounts committee along with his PC caucus colleagues have been trying to find answers from the McGuinty government over the \$1 Billion McGuinty eHealth scandal that saw hundreds of millions of dollars wasted on untendered contracts and sweetheart deals for Liberal-friendly consultants.

"We are not getting any straight answers," said Oshawa MPP, Jerry Ouellette, "all the McGuinty Liberals seem to be doing is hiding more and more from the people of Ontario."

The McGuinty eHealth scandal resulted in the resignation of Health Minister David Caplan. The former Minister is just one of many senior Liberals implicated in the scandal including Deputy Premier and former Health Minister George Smitherman who has, to date, dodged accountability for his role. The Auditor General's report also implicates Premier Dalton McGuinty as being personally involved in undermining oversight over eHealth's former CEO and Board Chair.

"The only person standing between Ontario families and the truth," said Ontario PC Party Leader Tim Hudak, "is Dalton McGuinty."
