OUELLETTE STANDS FIRMLY WITH PARENTS AGAINST DALTON MCGUINTY'S PLAN TO EXTEND SEX-EDUCATION INTO THE FIRST GRADE

(Queen's Park) – Jerry Ouellette MPP Oshawa and his PC Caucus colleagues declared their firm opposition to the McGuinty government's plan to introduce sex classes to children as young as six years old.

“As a legislator and as a parent, I believe that sex-ed should not be on the curriculum for students as young as six years old”, stated Oshawa MPP, Jerry Ouellette.

This is typical of Dalton McGuinty's nanny state politics. His government defended this move by saying they consulted with experts, academics and bureaucrats. What they refused to do is consult with parents.

In an attempt to deflect criticism from parents on this unpopular move, Liberal strategist Rob Silver used his *Globe and Mail* blog to label anyone who opposes the McGuinty sex-ed plan as being a “right wing activist” and a potential “bigot”. This is low even for Dalton McGuinty and his team, as thousands and thousands of Ontario families disagree with the idea of teaching sex classes to six year olds.

“Once more, this move demonstrates how out of touch Dalton McGuinty is with Ontario families”, adds Ouellette.
