## **Ouellette Continues to Urge Government to Stimulate Auto Sector to Support Autoworkers and Retirees**

### *Oshawa MPP Offers Suggestions on Behalf of Residents*

**(Queen's Park)** – Oshawa MPP, Jerry Ouellette read hundreds of names of Oshawa residents into the record today in support of a proposal that would immediately stimulate the auto sector during these troubled economic times.

Mr. Ouellette and his Progressive Conservative caucus colleagues have suggested a PST tax holiday on the purchase of new cars and trucks and a “Retire-Your-Ride” program which would offer Ontarians rebates for trading in their old vehicle and buying a new one.

The Oshawa MPP presented petitions on behalf of hundreds of constituents who supported the PST tax holiday proposal as an incentive for consumers that would also create jobs and spur our economy.

“These are serious times and all levels of government must work together with industry and labour, consider all options and find long-term solutions to ensure that autoworkers and retirees have a secure future in our community”, asserts Ouellette.

The Oshawa MPP, who is attending the CAW Pension Rally at Queen's Park this Thursday, admits he is directly affected by this issue. “My mother-in-law, my relatives, friends and staff are all directly dependent on the auto sector and are deeply concerned about their future”, reveals Ouellette.
